The WA project for Al Falah Kindergarten includes the following activities:

- Child Nutrition Programme (medical examinations of children, supplying nutritious food items on a daily basis in a healthy meal).
- Clothing (winter jackets, shoes).
- Educational support (covering fees, supplying stationery, bags and uniforms).
- Psychosocial support targeting both children and teachers.
- Rehabilitation of kitchens and toilets, and supplying clean drinking water.

The Kindergarten of Al Falah Charitable Society is located in Jabalya, the northern part of the Gaza Strip. It serves the community in Jabalya, Al Salam Area, and Ezbit Abed Rabo, areas hardest hit by the conflict of December 2008 to January 2009.
